The George Washington University Department of Prevention and Community Health is seeking qualified behavioral scientists to fill up to four (4) tenure track faculty positions. Rank for each position is open and commensurate with experience. Expertise is sought in, but not limited to, the areas of HIV/AIDS and interpersonal violence prevention. Responsibilities of the positions will include teaching graduate courses in the degree programs of the Department (MPH and DrPH); undertaking scholarship and obtaining external funding in the specific area of expertise; advising students in graduate public health educational programs; and broadly contributing to the research and educational mission of the Department.

Basic qualifications: Applicants must possess expertise and scholarly accomplishments in a behavioral or social science discipline. An earned doctoral degree or equivalent terminal degree is required; must have a demonstrated track record of ability to obtain external research funding; must have strong verbal and written English communication skills; should have evidence of leadership or leadership potential in their discipline;.

Preferred qualifications: Preference will be given to applicants who have a strong track record of funding and scholarly activities in the areas of HIV/AIDS, interpersonal violence prevention, familiarity with community-based participatory and health disparities research; experience in cross-disciplinary research approaches; and, a demonstrated record of successful teaching at the graduate level and of a strong commitment to diversity.
