The George Washington University School of Public Health and Health Services seeks an associate professor (tenure-track) for its Department of Health Policy. The individual who holds this position will occupy a central position in the Department. Responsibilities of the position include the development and teaching of one or more program offerings in comparative health policy, instruction in health policy analysis methods, and mentorship of masters and doctoral candidates. The individual also will be expected to develop significant research scholarship in the field of comparative health policy, including comparative workforce issues, coverage, quality and comparative effectiveness. The individual will collaborate closely with other faculty engaged in the field of comparative and global public health policy and practice.

**Basic Qualifications:** Applicants must hold a doctoral degree in public health, health policy, or a related discipline. Applicants should possess a well developed and nationally recognized expertise in comparative health policy and global health workforce policy and should have published extensively in these fields. Evidence of national and international engagement with academic and policy leadership in these fields is a key qualification -- particularly scholarship in the field of human resources for health. Applicants should have experience teaching in these fields. Applicants should have a strong reputation for teaching and scholarly collaboration at all levels. Applicants must have a demonstrated ability to secure, administer, and direct extramural support for advanced health services research.

**Preferred Qualifications:** Preference will be given to applicants who have a demonstrated capacity to work with research groups in the United States and elsewhere in regard to securing funds, carrying out research, and publishing scholarly findings. International experience and a record of having worked with international health organizations are desirable qualifications – particularly in regard to health workforce migration policy. Applicants should have the capacity to mentor graduate students in health policy at the master and doctoral levels.
